**“The Woman, The Child & The Dragon – A Heavenly Perspective on
the Tribulation” – Revelation 12**

Revelation Chapters 6-11 describe the events of the Tribulation up to the sounding of the seventh trumpet. Chapters 12-14 deal with the same period, but describe events from the heavenly standpoint. These chapters start with a look back in time to recount Satan’s initial rebellion against God and describe the climactic battle during the Tribulation. They will also detail the rise of the AntiChrist, the False Prophet and the ultimate failure of Satan’s efforts.
