"Triumph & Reaping" - Revelation 14

Chapter 14 is a Chapter of triumph and glory to God after the darkness of Chapter 13, which describes Satan, the Anti-Christ, the False Prophet, and the mark of the beast. Chapter 14 ushers in truth, righteousness and praise.

D. The Reaping – vv. 14- 20

This is the time of wrath – divine judgment. This passage pictures the final harvest of divine wrath in two agricultural ways: the grain harvest (vv. 14-16) and the grape harvest (vv.17-20). Both harvests can be described by the same three points:

1. The Reaper

a.	In the grain harvest vision,	the Son of Man is the Reaper (v	_' . 14)

b. In the grape harvest, the _____ are the Reapers (v. 17). Angels will announce Armageddon (Revelation 19:17) and will assist Jesus in the Final Judgment (Matthew 13:39).

2. The Ripeness

- a. In the grain harvest vision, the Angel delivers the message for the Father (symbolized as being in the Temple) to the Son of Man that it is time for Him to move in judgment (v. 15). The word "ripe" here is the word for something that is "dried up" or "withered."
- b. In the grape harvest, the word "ripe" is different (v. 17). This word means "fully ripe" or "in its fullness," and refers to the Earth's people as bursting with the juice of wickedness and ready for the harvest of righteousness.

3. The Reaping

- a. In the grain harvest vision, Jesus simply reaps the Earth no more fanfare, no more warning (v. 16).
- b. In the grape harvest, the wicked are gathered and thrown into the great winepress of the wrath of God (vv. 19-20).
