"The Bowl Judgments, Part 2" - Revelation 16:12-21

Review:

Last week, we explored the first 5 "bowl judgments," which were literal plagues, coming from the Greek ("plege") which means "a blow" or "wound." Those first 5 "pleges" were:

First Bowl: Foul Sores (vv. 1-2)

Second Bowl: The Sea Becomes Blood (v. 3)

Third Bowl: Rivers and Springs Become Blood (vv. 4-7)

Fourth Bowl: Scorching Heat of the Sun (vv. 8-9)

Fifth Bowl: Darkness (vv. 10-11)

Sixth Bowl: The Euphrates Dried Up (vv. 12-16)

- The Euphrates is 1700-mile-long. It runs from Turkey, through Syria and the center of Iraq, so it has remained a focus of worldwide attention
- It has been at the center of human history since Eden (Genesis 2:14) and was the border of the land promised to Abraham. (Genesis 15:18)
- It once served as the Eastern boundary of the Roman Empire.
