**Revelation 21 – 22:5 - “All Things Made New”**

***The Appearance of the New Heaven and the New Earth (v. 1)***

**2 Peter 3:13**

**Isaiah 65:17**

**Isaiah 66:22**

The word “new” means new in a \_\_\_\_\_ sense. Job 15:15 and Isaiah 24:5. The new earth has no \_\_\_\_\_.

***The Capital of the New Heaven and the New Earth (v. 2)***

The new Jerusalem is an \_\_\_\_\_ city. It is a new eternal city. (see v. 10).

***The Person of God in the New Heaven and the New Earth (v. 3)***

“the Tabernacle of God is among men” could be translated “God has \_\_\_\_\_ with His people.”

***The Changes in the New Heaven and the New Earth (vv. 4-6a)***

***The Outcasts from the New Heaven and the New Earth (v. 8)***

This just reaffirms the saving power of the Gospel – compare 1 Corinthians 6:9-11

## ***The New Jerusalem (vv. 9-21)***

As the vision of the New Jerusalem unfolds, let's remember that history has ended, and time is no more. John and his readers are transported to the eternal state. John was not the only one to write about the heavenly Jerusalem. The writer of Hebrews described the city as follows in Hebrews 12:22-24 & Hebrews 13:14.

### ***a. Its Appearance (vv. 9-11)***

- The New Jerusalem is described as the \_\_\_\_\_ because it draws its character from its occupants. Those occupants consist of the bride of the Lamb – a title originally given to the \_\_\_\_\_ but now extended to encompass the redeemed of all ages
