

**“Mighty God”  
Isaiah 9:6**

In this Second Sunday of Advent, we continue to celebrate the first coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and look forward to His Second Coming. Today, we turn once again to the prophecies of Isaiah as to His Coming, and what He would be called. Isaiah wrote that He would be called “Mighty God.” In Hebrew, the two words of this one name are “*El Gibbor*”:
